iLOOKOUT AT A GLANCE

The iLookOut training features an interactive storyline that uses experiential learning to educate learners on child abuse, reasonable suspicion, and reporting procedures. It is designed to engage learners, empower them with knowledge, and provide a safe learning environment. The training has been shown to improve knowledge and attitudes related to child abuse and reporting.

iLOOKOUT IN PENNSYLVANIA

An NIH-funded research study is underway to identify the most effective strategy for preparing mandated reporters to support at-risk children and families, which includes identifying and reporting suspected child maltreatment as well as being able to distinguish poverty from neglect.

The iLookOut Training, which can be completed over multiple sessions on your smartphone, tablet, or computer, has 2 parts:

1. Mandated Reporter Training: interactive video-based storyline (3 hours total)
2. Advanced Training: 5-12-minute animated micro-learning exercises (3 hours total)

Completing both iLookOut Trainings will:

- Satisfy Act 31 mandated reporter training requirements
- Satisfy Act 126 requirements for Pennsylvania teachers
- Earn you 6 hours of early childhood Professional Development credit from the PA Key (free of charge)
- Help us determine the most effective way to prepare mandated reporters to support at-risk children and families
